Minutes of the December 21, 2020 Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Lower Brushy Creek WCID

In accordance with the Governor's emergency proclamation suspending certain provisions of the Texas Open Meetings Act effective March 16, 2020 in response to the COVID-19 virus, all persons, including Board members and members of the public may participate in the meeting remotely by videoconferencing using the instructions included on the posted agenda. Due to COVID-19 social gathering restrictions, all members of the public and the board may not physically enter the Greater Taylor Chamber of Commerce offices. Therefore, the meeting tookplace in person and on Zoom Videoconferencing.

President Ed Komandosky called the Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Lower Brushy Creek WCID to order at 7:31 am on Monday December 21, 2020. Board Members present at the meeting location included Scott Ging, Monica Masters and Allen David. Others present at the meeting location included General Manager Jim Clarno and Board Attorney Ted Hejl. Others present via Zoom included Treasurer Mike Schneider, PR/Webpage Consultant Richard Stone and District Clerk Sue Lilly.

Ed Komandosky called the meeting to order and announced that a quorum was present.

There were no citizen's communications.

General Manager, Jim Clarno, presented for consideration and approval the August 24th, 2020, October 19, 2020 and November 2, 2020 Board Meeting Minutes. A motion to approve the minutes was made by Director Allen David, seconded by Vice President Scott Ging, and approved by a vote of 5-0.

Clarno presented for consideration and possible action to approve the following financial reports: Checking Account Register for October 2020 and Checking Account Register for November 2020. A motion to approve the financial reports was made by Secretary Masters, seconded by Director David, and approved by a vote of 5-0.

Clarno presented for consideration and possible action to approve *Task Order No 2 for Spring Operation, Maintenance and Related Services* for fertilizer, herbicide application, spot spraying, seeding, sprigging and related work to TerraSol, LLC. A motion was made by Vice President Gingm, seconded by Director David, and approved by a vote of 5-0.

Clarno presented for consideration and possible action to approve Amendments to the Cooperative Agreements for the Lower Brushy Creek Site 20 Rehabilitation Project to extend the completion date to June 30, 2021. Amendment No 1 to the Cooperative Agreement LB20-RHB-ST-010-20 for State Funds and Amendment No 2 to the Cooperative Agreement LB20-FED-79015 for Federal funds. A motion was made by Secretary Masters, seconded by Vice President Ging, and approved by a vote of 5-0.

Clarno presented for consideration and possible action regarding Lower Brushy Creek Watershed Site Nos. 12 and 22 Repair Projects:

First, an approval of a construction Contract Agreement No LBC-2021-02 with Solid Bridge Construction LLC of Huntsville, Texas in the amount of \$1,057,616. A motion was made by Secretary Masters, seconded by Director Allen, and approved by a vote of 5-0.

Second, an approval of the Appointment of Contracting Officer. A motion was made by Vice President Ging, seconded by Director Allen and approved by a vote of 4-0-1 (Secretary Master abstained from the vote).

Lastly, an approval of an Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement with Clarno Consulting, LLC. A motion was made by Director Allen, seconded by Secretary Masters, and approved by a vote of 5-0.

Note: Treasurer Schneider left the meeting at this time.

Clarno shared for consideration and possible action regarding submission of a grant application to the Texas State Soil and Water Conservation Board for the upgrade of Sites 9, 29 and 30. A motion was made by Vice President Ging, seconded by Director Allen, and approved by a vote of 4-0.

 NRCS office is still closed to visitors, but NRCS and WCID may enter and use the office at any time.

NRCS has approved the installation of Suddenlink WiFi service to the WCID.

Dam Operation & Maintenance

Annual dam inspections are scheduled for January 12th, 14th, 19th and 21st.

 Task Order No. 2 for spring O&M will include herbicide and fertilizer application, spot spraying, removal of some woody brush, reseeding, sprigging and other related maintenance. The work is scheduled to begin in mid-February.

Capital Improvements

- Site 20 Rehab Contractor has finished all lime processing, rock rip-rap installation and has placed the black dirt on the work areas. Work remaining includes fencing, removal of construction trailer and equipment, sprigging and final clean-up.
- Site 12 and 22 Repair projects The Contract Agreement with Solid Bridge Construction
 has been executed and the pre-construction meeting was held on December 23rd. The
 contractor is providing bonds, insurance and initial submittals. Notice to Proceed will be
 issued with the official start date as of January 18, 2021. The contractor will begin work at
 Site 12 and then move to Site 22.
- Site 18 Upgrade a letter was received from the State Board dated December 29th confirming tentative funding for this project this fiscal year. The WCID will need to provide documentation that is it has (1) sufficient land rights to complete the project, (2) completed an Emergency Action Plan for the site and (3) sufficient funds for its local match.

To All Sponsors of Federal Rehab and State Funded Upgrade Projects:

Most of the designs of federal rehab projects and state funded upgrade projects are near 90% completion. After analyzing available state funding and project readiness, we can now estimate which projects might be funded for construction. Project readiness means that by March 31, 2021, final designs are completed and approved, and that the sponsors have emergency action plans (EAP), land rights certification, and 404 permits. In addition, federal rehab projects must have a newly executed O&M agreement with NRCS.

The following list of dams are in priority order based on (1) availability of federal funding (top priority), (2) projects listed in the ESF \$150 Million Plan (second priority), and (3) Other dams ranked by Risk Index determined from the "NRCS Evaluation of Potential Rehab Projects".

1. Federally funded rehab projects estimated to be ready, and state match funding available:

Cedar Creek 87A
Chambers Creek 10 and 11
Lower Running Water Draw 4
Plum Creek 10 and 21

As stated, the above ranking is "estimated" and could change if some projects are not ready as expected, projects are canceled by sponsors, or currently available state funding is reduced by the Texas legislature.

In order to meet funding deadlines, we will begin sending agreements for construction funds to sponsors for signature in January, even though the projects are not yet "ready". Sponsors must return signed agreements to TSSWCB as soon as possible, but no later than May 31, 2021 in order to obligate funding before funds expiration.

We will hold the sponsor-signed agreements here at TSSWCB until all requirements are met. When the final design is approved (by NRCS or TCEQ), and sponsors have obtained EAP, land rights, 404 permits, and for federal rehab - new O&M agreements, we will be able to quickly execute agreements for construction funding for those projects until all available funding is obligated. Sponsors should begin contracting for construction in March, April or May 2021, and must begin no later than July 2021.

For any projects not funded, we will complete the designs and hold for potential future funding in FY 2022 (begins September 1, 2021) or later fiscal years.
