Minutes of the March 27, 2023  
Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Lower Brushy Creek WCID

President Ed Komandosky called the Regular Meeting of the Board of Directors of the Lower Brushy Creek WCID to order at 7:31am on Monday March 27, 2023 and announced that a quorum was present. Board members present included Vice President Scott Ging, Secretary/Treasurer Monica Masters, Director Allen David and Director Laine Holman. Others present included, General Manager Jim Clarno, District Clerk Sue Lilly, Board Attorney Mark Schroeder, and District Conservationist Jess Anderson.

There were no citizens communications.

General Manager, Jim Clarno, presented for consideration and approval the February 20th, Regular Called Meeting Minutes. A motion was made by Director Allen David to approve the meeting minutes as presented. The motion was seconded by Vice President Scott Ging and approved by a vote of 5-0.

Clarno presented for consideration and approval of the Checking Account Register for February 2023. A motion was made by Secretary/Treasurer Monica Masters to approve the financial reports as presented. The motion was seconded by Director Allen and approved by a vote of 5-0.

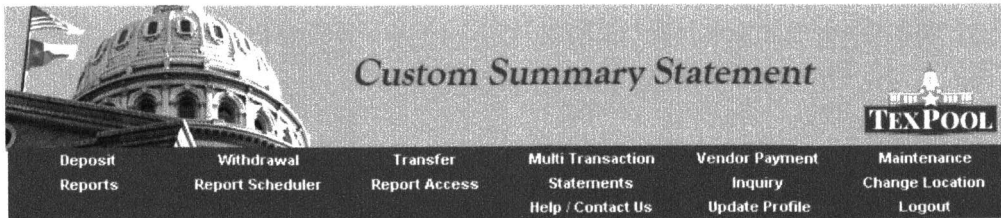

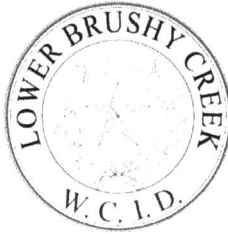

### **BOARD APPROVED POLICY**

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#### **FENCE AND GRAZING POLICY**

**Background** – At the time of the original construction of the Lower Brushy Creek WCID's earthen dams and auxiliary spillways, the Owners executed permanent easements allowing the WCID to construct, operate, maintain, repair or rehabilitate the structures. Those easements were filed with the County Clerk and can be found in the Official Public Records of the County. If requested, the WCID will make a reasonable effort to assist with obtaining a copy of that easement for the current Landowner.

#### **Ownership, easement and repairs**

- As part of the original construction of the earthen dams and auxiliary spillways, WCID installed fencing around each structures along with the necessary gates and/or gaps. That fence is the sole property of the WCID.
- The WCID is responsible for the repair and/or replacement of the fencing as it deems necessary.
- The Landowner should notify the WCID if any repairs are needed.
- If the WCID fencing is cut or animals damage the fence, the WCID will repair as required.
- If the WCID determines that the Landowner or his leasee has cut or otherwise damaged the fence, the Landowner shall be responsible for the cost to repair or replace the fencing.
- The original permanent easement includes the right of ingress and egress over the Landowner's property. The WCID will make every effort to work with the Landowner locate such access over a route satisfactory to the both the WCID and the Landowner.

### **Grazing**

- The easements generally included language that the Landowner shall not graze within the easement without written permission from the WCID.
- Landowners shall avoid overgrazing the dam and/or emergency spillway.
- Landowner shall remove animals from dam and/or emergency spillway following significant rainfall events to avoid creating animal trails and resulting damage to the dam and/or spillway.
- WCID may issue a written notice to the Landowner asking that he/she remove animals from the dam and/or emergency if it determines that the animals need to be removed.
- If the Landowner and/or the leasee ignore that notice, the Board of Directors of the WCID may issue an Order to the Landowner to remove animals from the dam and/or spillway to allow for the restoration of the grass cover, repair of erosion or animal trails, construction, etc.
- The Landowner may request the release of the Order. The WCID will inspect the structure and may allow that release.
